### English

As part of our topic we will be reading Tom's midnight garden and investigating what might happen if the clock struck 13.

Each week we will be recapping a different genre that we have learnt about in the past and writing our own versions.

### Maths

### Science

We will be looking at the changes as humans develop from babies through to old age. We will spend time comparing the life processes of reproduction in humans and other animals.

### RE

This term will focus on the festivals of harvest Diwali (19<sup>th</sup> Oct) and Christmas.

### Art and design technology

This term we will create sketch books to record our observations. We will improve our mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials.

We will be looking at the work of famous artists including: Andy Warhol and Salvador Dali.

### PSHE

We will be looking at puberty and how our bodies change as we grow older. We will learn how to look after our bodies and stay clean.

We will also be taking part in a project with local care home: Chaxhill Hall. Building relationships with the residents.

### MFL

We will be learning how to talk about ourselves and our bodies, what we look like and what we wear.

### Computing

Use digital sensors to monitor sound/ light/ temperature over time. Use software to graph the results.

We will also use software to create digital images and portraits.

### PE

Miss Loomes will be teaching PE every week. This term the focus will be on tennis and gymnastics.

### History

Children will be given the opportunity to choose an aspect of everyday life and find out how it has changed over the past 200 years e.g. cars, clothes, entertainment. This will be linked with the 150 year celebrations of the school. We will investigate how the school has changed since it first opened.
