

**Communication, language and literacy:**

Letters and Sounds activities: Revising initial sounds and learning to read and write three-letter words  
Guided reading activities  
Building a sight vocabulary of commonly used words  
Mark-making, handwriting and pencil play activities  
Speaking and listening activities.  
Listening and responding to Traditional Tales and stories and poetry about woodland animals, e.g. The Gruffalo and Percy the Park Keeper,  
Writing activities linked to these stories

**Physical development:**

Continue to develop fine-motor control, mark-making, finger-gym and handwriting activities.  
Using small games apparatus in P.E. sessions  
Taking part in dance sessions on our 'animal theme', swimming lessons  
Using tools and manipulating materials in art and craft activities

**Mathematics:**

Continue activities to support reading, writing and ordering numbers to 10  
Addition and subtraction activities  
Sorting and naming 2 dimensional shapes, making pictures and patterns with shapes,

**Understanding the world:**

Looking for signs of spring and new life outdoors, learning names of baby animals and what they need to survive,

Learning names of native woodland animals, birds and flowers in the local area and in woodland habitats  
Using computers and I-Pads to support our learning

**Expressive arts and design:**
