Money and shopping activities linked to the role play 'baker's shop' and selling our cakes in the cafe/ shop.

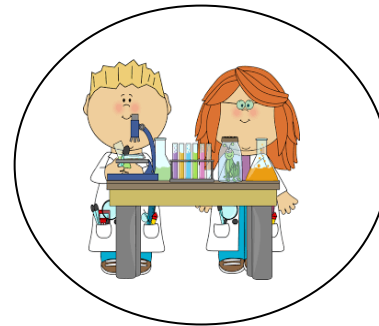
Estimating and weighing ingredients and foodstuffs, measuring liquids for cookery and science activities.
