

English

Over the next term the children will be learning about a range of texts based on food topics and creating their own pieces of writing based on:

- Recipes and Instructions
- Nonsense Poetry
- Non-chronological reports (based on James Lind)
- Recount (based on a school visit)

The children will also undertake weekly grammar and comprehension sessions as well as daily guided reading groups.

Mathematics

This term in maths the children will be covering:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- X2, x5, x10, x3 and x4 Tables
- Big Maths – Mental maths activities

Science

Our science topic this term is 'Healthy Eating and Teeth'

- The children will find out about what it means to have a balanced diet and the importance of eating food from each food group. They will undertake a sugary investigation to find out how much sugar is inside a range of soft drinks. The children will then learn about different types of teeth and their purposes. Afterwards, they will be able to draw and annotate the inside of a tooth and be able to explain what is necessary to look after their health and hygiene.

Religious Education

- The children will be learning the fundamental beliefs and values of Judaism. This will include learning about what festivals are celebrated and understanding why family life matters to Jewish people.

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Medium Term Plan - Spring 2018

Geography

In geography the children will be able to:

- Locate geographical features on a map using an atlas and using symbols shown in a key.
- Explain information about Fairtrade products and where they come from.
- Track the journey of a banana from its country of origin to the fruit bowl.
- Identify and place a range of food products on a world map.
- Describe and compare different human and physical features.

Music

- The children will be learning to use the app 'Garage Band' on the iPad to compose atmospheric music.

Design and Technology

Food

The focus of DT – food will begin with looking at hygiene and the importance of hand washing when handling food. They will also begin understanding where food comes from. The children will then create instructional posters followed by writing a recipe for an alternative sugary treat.

Product Design

Part 1: The children will be analysing, evaluating, creating, developing and designing their own chocolate wrappers.

Part 2: Mr Neale will be teaching the children about how cams work. They will be designing and creating their own moving shop window display using cams and based on the characters from the film 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.'

PSHE

This term the children will discover what it means to practise democracy. They will learn about the importance of rules and rights as well as understanding their place within the community.

Physical Education

Miss Loomes will continue working with the children in PE this term. This term the children will be learning to play hockey.
